Neighbors,

The Gleneagles Paint Committee is excited to be sharing information with you about the new colors that have been selected for our neighborhood. This document also includes information about upcoming Open House events where you will be able to view the color choices as well as details regarding the color choice selection and assignment processes.

In order to provide you with as many choices as possible, we have selected 8 color combinations. This actually gives you 16 possible choices, as each color combination can be reversed with regard to main body and trim colors. The selections include warm, neutral and cool tones which should work with any homeowners' current décor. Your front door and frame will get an update as well, with a choice of 8 accent colors. We have attached a document which includes each of the color schemes for you to explore. They are labeled 1a, 1b, 2a, 2b, etc., so that you can easily identify your color selection. All color schemes with an "a" in their description have a light body and darker trim; all schemes with a "b" in their description have a darker body and light trim.

To help you in your decision making process we have designed a variety of tools to help you make the best color choice for your home. The tools include open houses, color boards of the schemes which can be checked out, thumbnail images of homes in the colors we have selected, a Pinterest page displaying colors and Sherwin-Williams color numbers for each choice.

Open Houses

There will be three Open House events where you will be able to view all the possible combinations of colors for the main body, trim and front door/frame. Using the Sherwin-Williams Visualizer tool, we created images which illustrate how the paint will look on an actual home in our neighborhood. In addition to these images, we will have boards on display which have been painted to show the various color combinations.

- 1. Forms will be available at the open houses for you to complete if you are ready to make your selections.
- 2. You can take a form, complete it with your choices and drop it off in the basket at the Rouleau's 20832 Gleaneagles Links Drive anytime before midnight, April 8th.
- 3. You can download the form from the Gleneagles website, complete the form and drop it off at the Rouleau's- 20832 Gleaneagles Links Drive anytime before midnight, April 8th.
- 4. You can email the information to gleneaglespaint2019@gmail.com making sure to include the following information:
- A. Name
- B. Address
- C. House choice 1, door color
- D. House choice 2, door color

- E. House choice 3, door color
- F. Medallion color trim or body

Your email must be received by midnight EST, April 8th

The deadline for owners to submit their color choices is Midnight EST, April 8th, 2019. Any owner not meeting this deadline will be assigned a color from the default colors selected by the committee.

Just a reminder that a lottery process will be used to select the color for your home. This lottery will take place on Wednesday, April 10th at 4:00 p.m. in the Lakes Room. You do not need to be present at this drawing to receive one of your 3 color choices. Just a reminder no 2 homes adjacent to each other may be the same exact color scheme. Owners will be notified by email prior to April 18th with the final color of their home.
